Sub : INTERMEDIATE EDUCATION - Functioning of Government Junior Colleges for the academic year **2012-2013** - Certain clarifications issued.

3. Minutes of meeting held with Government Junior Lecturers Association of A.P., Hyderabad on 2-8-2012.

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Certain instructions were issued vide Proceedings 1st read above with regard to admission into I & II year Intermediate Courses and timings of Government Junior Colleges for the academic year 2012-13. Further instructions were also issued vide Circular 2nd read above with regard to Mana-TV Lessons.

It is clarified that, all the GJC's will function fully between 9-30 A.M. to 4-00 P.M. However, those college which have Mana-TV facility shall attend the Lectures from 9-00 A.M. along with students. Only concerned subject Junior Lecturer shall attend Mana-TV class on a particulars day and the other JL's stay is not compulsory. In the evening many JL's who are feeling a sense of social responsibility are already conducting special coaching classes for students from 4-00 PM to 5-00 PM. It is also clarified that, the Principal of the college shall not insist upon the JL's to sit in the college compulsorily beyond 4-00 PM except when they have some specific work on a particular day.

With regard to uneconomic strength in sections it is clarified that, no section will be closed down without proper scrutiny and examination. Especially, sections with single digit students will be taken up in the first phase and such proposals will be sought from districts and they will be examined and brought to the notice of the Government.

Instructions are being issued to the DVEO's to place the Senior-most Junior Lecturer in the district as In-charge/F.A.C. Principal in newly establishing Government Junior Colleges. It is clarified that the purpose of giving instructions was to ensure that senior JL's are not bypassed in the matters of giving responsibilities of the Principal. However, the DVEO's are hereby instructed to offer this responsibility to Senior-most JL. If a particular Senior JL is not interested the DVEO shall offer next Senior JL and so on till a person is appointed. They shall obtain consent from the Senior JL's in writing to avoid subsequent problems and controversies.

The above instructions shall be followed scrupulously.
