The General Secretary, Government Junior Lecturer's Association, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in his representation 3rd read above, has requested to preserve proportionate Earned Leave to the Principals/ Junior Lecturers/ Physical Directors/ Librarians working in Government Junior Colleges in the state who are involved in conduct of Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations May/ June 2009 in summer vacation during the academic year 2008-2009.

The Government in their Memo,dt.13.05.09 has issued instructions to follow the guidelines issued in G.O.Rt.No.421, Higher Education[IE.I] Department,dt.04.06.01 with regard to preservation of proportionate Earned Leaves to the staff who were prevented from availing summer vacation due to their involvement in conduct of examinations, census duty and Election duty etc., and reducing the summer vacation period due to increase of working days from 180 to 220 days.

The Regional Joint Directors of Intermediate Education and the Principals of Government Junior Colleges in the state are permitted to preserve 04[four days] of Earned Leave to the Principals/ Junior Lecturers / Physical Directors/ Librarians working in Government Junior Colleges who were involved in conduct of Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations MAY 2009 in summer vacation duly obtaining the attendance certificates from the authorities concerned.

The Regional Joint Directors of Intermediate Education/ Principals of Government Junior Colleges in the state are requested to make necessary entries in the service registers of the incumbents to that effect.
